Students will also have the chance to observe surgeries, adoptions, surrenders, and many other facets of day to day shelter life.

This program is designed for students with a real passion for animals, preferably ones that want to work with animals in the future.

- Campers are required to bring their own lunch. We do not have refrigeration available, so please plan accordingly.
- For safety, campers are required to wear closed-toe shoes.
- Students will observe a surgery, please let us know if you are NOT comfortable ahead of time
