

FOSTER PET EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Emergency - Call shelter backline 8am-6pm, otherwise call foster cell phone

Lost Foster Major Wounds / Excessive Bleeding Unresponsive Straining / Unable to produce urine

Hit by Car / Seriously Injured Unable to Stand or Walk

Having Trouble Breathing Seizure/Unstable/Disoriented

Cold to the Touch Neonates not Eating, Weight Loss, Severe Diarrhea Injury to the Eye

White or Blue/Very Pale/Sticky Gums

Pregnant Animal in Distress

Temperature </= 97.0 F or >/= 105.0 F

Urgent - Email or call shelter backline, we will follow up the next business day

Vomiting Multiple Times Lethargy/Not Eating Colored Nasal Discharge Incident of Aggression

Ingested Dangerous Items

Diarrhea Multiple Times Over 24hrs (6 weeks or older)

Chewed/Removed Sutures/Staples

Slightly Open Spay Incisions

Less Urgent – Email and we will follow up the next business day

Dry Hacking Cough (dog) Pink or bloody urine

Vomiting Once or Twice Diarrhea for more than 24hrs

Lethargy/Low Appetite Limping

Dirty/Smelly Ears Congestion/Clear Nasal Discharge Intestinal Parasites/Worms in Stool Skin Irritation
